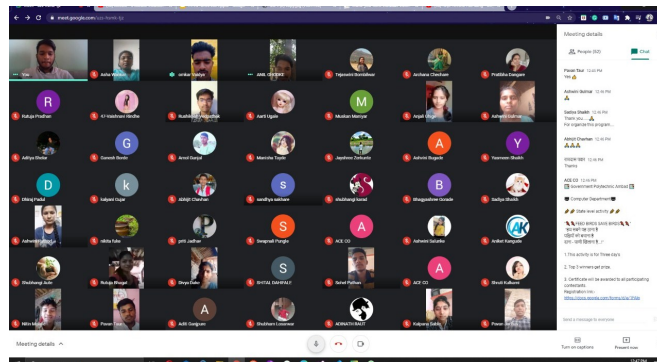
# Online Speech Competition
